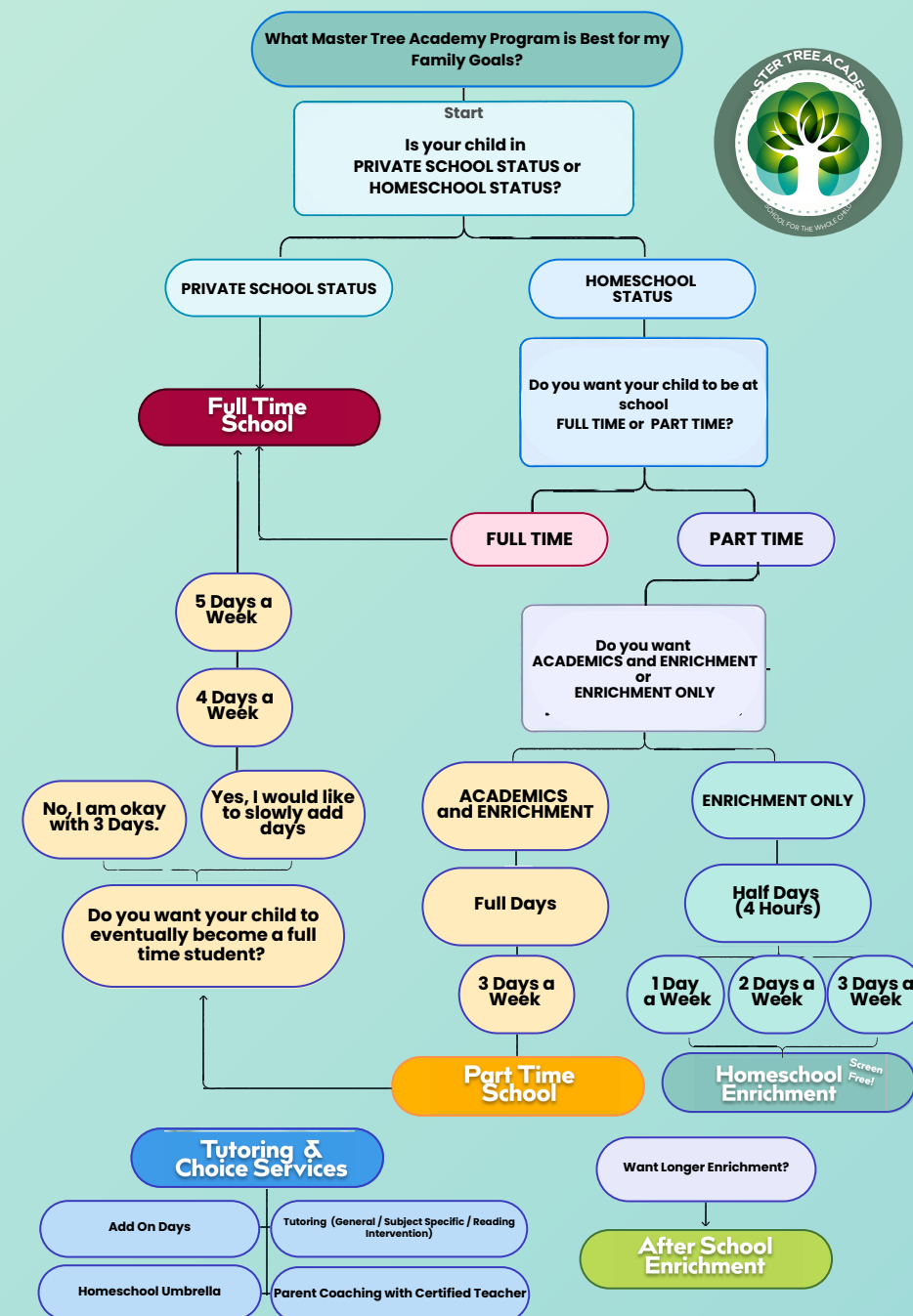

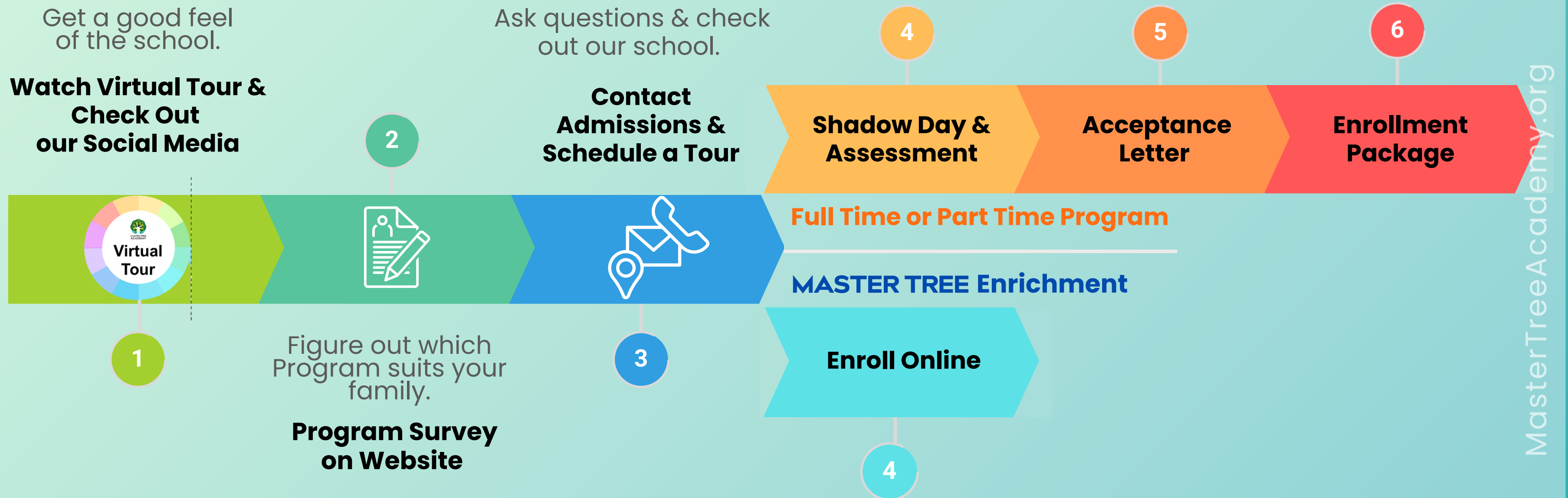

## Enrollment

If you are interested in applying for a placement of your student, please book a student assessment Shadow Day Experience with us by submitting your student application form. Once your application and student assessment is approved and you decided on the choice program your student, the last step of your enrollment process takes you through submitting applicable forms and making your tuition deposit and enrollment fee (due at time of enrollment) and material fee investment. Depending on which Master Tree Academy program you choose, additional forms (health exams, vaccination records may need to be submitted. Please review the Parent Handbook. See the links for downloading and printing your first form.

## Tuition Payments & Discounts

Master Tree Academy annual tuition can be made in monthly installments or as one-time annual payment with 5% tuition discount. Payments to Master Tree Academy can be done by check, online payments (Stripe, Paypal, Credit Cards) or through ZELLE or ACH wire directly to our bank account. In addition, we grant a 10% Sibling Discount on your tuition for the first, 10% for each additional sibling (material and enrollment fees are not discounted.) When paying with online payment processors, additional charges (up to 3%) may occur for you. Monthly tuition installments are due on the 5th of the month. A late payment charge of \$29 occurs after.

## Student Assessment & Placement (Grade)

Student placement depends on the assessment and is at the discretion of the teacher and administration. Master Tree Academy takes all elements into consideration when delegating classroom/tier/grade placement.
